DEFORMATIONAL PLAGIOCEPHALY (DP)

1 in 2 infants have some degree of DP

Common risk factors include:

- Positioning in the womb / multiples
 - Prematurity
 - Torticollis (crooked neck)
- · Back to sleep (recommended by AMA)
 - Containment devices

Early identification and treatment can prevent the need for a helmet to treat the flat spot

Contact Mountain Kidz Therapy IF:

- Notice head shape changes (flattening along back of head)
- Observe that baby prefers looking to one side
 - Pediatrician is recommending helmet evaluation
